George Bowen spoke on behalf of the non-instructional union. They do not have a problem with the plan but the route that was taken to address it. According to chapter 447 of the Labor Laws states that any salary changes or paying upfront fees is subject to bargaining and needs to start on the negotiating table with the union before it is presented to the Board for action. He also mentioned that he has an interest for all employees that the union represents and not only the bus drivers.

Charlotte Ellison, President of the Non-Instructional Union, also reiterated that they do not have a problem with the plan of action but simply wanted to ensure that we are maintaining the integrity of the contract. Also they want to be fair to all departments and not single out the bus drivers. She also agreed that this discussion should start at the bargaining table with the Non-Instructional Union and not directly with the Board.

Kenneth Dennis, mentioned that we needed to discuss it with our legal council, Attorney Angela Ball. Attorney Ball, said she would discuss it but not in this forum it would need to be discussed in a legal session. With that Danny Glover made a motion to postpone this item after negotiation has taken place, seconded by Kenneth Dennis, the Board agreed to postpone this agenda item.
