

What K through 5th grade parents can do to help their student be successful?

- 1. Attend school every day.
- 2. Encourage reading, read aloud to your child, and read at least 20 minutes every day.

What 6th through 8th grade parents can do?

- 1. Send your student to school every day.
- 2. Review your student's planner nightly.
- 3. Make sure you know your student's FOCUS information and check it at least once a week.
- 4. Ask your student how their day went and what they learned. Be involved in their education.

What 9th through 12th grade parents can do?

- 1. Attend all requested meetings when invited by the school.
- 2. Volunteer in any capacity that you feel comfortable.
- 3. Report any/ all incidents that could put the schools safety at risk.
- 4. Support school interventions that are put in place to help your child be successful.
